SMARTSCAPES Program Client Pre-Survey Questions

Please answer the following questions to the best of your ability. If you are unsure of how to answer any of the questions, you may wait to answer the question with the Master Gardener volunteer.

Note: For the safety of our volunteers, we reserve the right to forego sampling and evaluating properties where pets cannot be removed from the sampling area during the stated evaluation time frame.

Soil Test: Do you know your soil?

- My lawn/garden/beds (circle which ones apply) have been soil tested.
- I make adjustments to my soil pH based on the soil report.
- My soil is predominately: clay/sand (circle one).
- I use compost as an amendment to improve my soil.

Match Plants to Site

- I know which areas of my yard are sunny, shady or in between.
- I know which areas of my yard are well drained or poorly drained.
- I have identified the plants in my landscape.
- I know which plants are in the right site because they are thriving.
- When selecting new plants, I select the right plant for the site.
- I select healthy, disease-free plants.

Arrange Plants

- I dig a wide, shallow hole when planting trees and shrubs.
- I do not amend planting holes for single trees or shrubs.
- I do amend entire planting beds with compost.
- I think about plant placement /mature size when choosing plants.

Rain and Irrigation

- I avoid light, frequent watering. Instead, I water deeply as needed.
- I irrigate early in the morning to reduce evaporation and discourage disease-avoiding overhead watering.

Trouble Free Installation and Maintenance

- I install new plants in the spring or fall and water these until established.
- I remove dead, dying, diseased, and damage limbs whenever I see them.
- I prune plants in the proper time of year.
- I identify insects, weeds, and diseases before attempting to control them.
- I physically remove pests when possible.
- When pesticides are needed, I choose the least toxic to protect beneficial insects.
- I read and follow all label directions when applying pesticides.
